OLD BUSINESS

ENWICC ADDRESS HAS BEEN CHANGED

Boyd Ready reported that the new post office box is now in Lincoln. He explained why we are changing the address of the old box. Its location is now at the Gateway Station. The new address is PO Box 5838, Lincoln, NE 68505. The Bellevue mail will be forwarded to the Lincoln station until October 2014. Then we will do a change of address which will cover us until October 2015. Roy Murabito said that we won't have any activity until the Swap Meet approaches and the Scholarship time comes around. Jim Snyder or Boyd Ready will file the new information with the Secretary of State for the State of Nebraska. The address has already been changed on our web site and in our newsletter. Jim Snyder will change the information on the swap meet flyers and on the scholarship application forms.

WEB SITE UPDATE
