

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### **CANCELLATION OF MEADOWLARK “A” ALL-FORD SHOW IN BENSON**

The annual All-Ford show hosted by the Meadowlark Model A Club of Omaha that was scheduled for July 28<sup>th</sup> was cancelled after a conflict arose between the organizers of the Benson Days Q125 parade and the Meadowlark “A’s”. Parade officials wanted to run the parade through the middle of the streets designated for use by the car show during the show, which was rejected by the club. With no compromise in hand, leaders of the Meadowlark “A’s” decided to cancel the event at the last minute rather than run the risk of having the parade pass through the show venue. This marks the second car show in the Omaha area that has been cancelled this year due to outside influences from local municipalities or civic organizations.

### **H&H All-Chevy Show**

Boyd Ready noted that H&H Chevrolet held their annual All-Chevy Show at their dealership at 84<sup>th</sup> & L in Omaha on Sunday, July 15<sup>th</sup>. Despite 100-degree temperatures over 250 entries were reported. Many of the Council’s Chevrolet-based clubs were in attendance to promote their groups.

### **Cook Poker Run/Raffle/Auction Raises Money for Cancer Victim**

Roger Neeman gave an overview of a fund-raiser held for the family of a local car enthusiast in Cook who is suffering from terminal cancer. Several people donated their time and parts in order to put back together a 1971 Oldsmobile Cutlass convertible in less than three weeks in order for his family and he to participate in the Poker Run. Proceeds from the poker run, a raffle, live auction and street dance raised \$42,000 for the family’s medical expenses. Roger added that shortly after the event, the man entered into hospice care.

Tom Dingwell reported that the Rebels of Lincoln had 171 vehicles registered for their show. Other events discussed included the show in downtown Fremont the Saturday after the Fourth of July, which drew over 200 cars.
