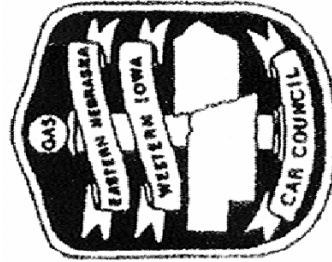
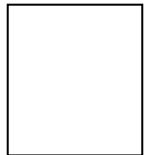

MEETING MINUTES - December 18, 2013

INTRODUCTIONS

VP Roy Murabito called the meeting to order at 7:33 PM in Omaha, NE.

GUEST SPEAKER

Austin Duren from the Omaha Storm Chasers baseball club addressed the Council to solicit interest in an old car night at Werner Park some time during the 2014 season. Ideas being discussed for participants include voting for ‘best car’ before the game with the top vote-getter being given the opportunity to take a lap around the warming track with their vehicle before the game. Anticipated entry fee would be similar to their ‘mini-package’ promotions at \$25 to \$30/vehicle with admission for up to 4 people per vehicle to the night’s game.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Boyd Ready motioned, with a second by DJ Hogan, to approve the November minutes as printed. Motion passed.

TREASURER’S REPORT

The Treasurer’s report was given by Boyd Ready and accepted after a motion made by DJ Hogan and seconded from the floor to approve. Bills were presented by Secretary Alan Tast for \$125.06 for printing and mailing of the December newsletter; a motion was made by Kerry Fox and seconded by DJ Hogan to pay the bills. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

2014 ROCKY MANGINELLI SWAP MEET

Jobs: Kerry Fox announced that most jobs had been confirmed by previous holders. Confirmations are needed from Cruisin' Classics and Rebels of Lincoln and Omaha VW Club. An opening may exist for a 3am spotter crew. Those clubs wanting to review their previous job assignments and verify if they want to drop, keep or change jobs must contact Kerry by calling 402-499-9711 or email kfox@inebraska.com.

2015-2017 Date Confirmations: Kerry and Boyd Ready visited with the Event Center manager prior to his retirement and confirmed the following dates for the 2015-2017 Swap Meets: 2015 – March 7-8; 2016 – March 5-6; 2017 – March 4-5

Facility Improvements: To follow up on previous reports, the Event Center is pushing back construction of a new building to 2016, while the concession stand that was under construction in the Expo Hall/Pavillion 3 will be open for 2014, with seating/eating area in the Expo Hall, meaning a potential loss of spaces. Kerry also reported that the area east of the Amy Countryman Pavillion has been paved. Talk is that grass lots on the north edge of the facility may be paved in 2014 after the Swap Meet.

Food Bank Milestone: Roger Neeman reminded all that monetary and food donations anticipated for the 2014 Swap Meet should push the overall totals over \$100,000/100,000-pounds since the program began 21 years ago. In order to promote these milestones, Roger asked at the Lincoln meeting for ideas on how to acknowledge this during the meet. Chuck Garber recommended that local media be informed of this in order to get news coverage, while Kerry suggested that signs should be made for display on the grounds and at the gates pointing out amounts donated to date with a "Thank You" to those who have donated. Alan added that the Council can play up the goal of breaking \$100,000/100,000 pounds by publicizing it in the Council newsletter, on the Council website, in the Calendar of Events book and by issuing press releases in conjunction with the Food Bank of Lincoln.

2014 CALENDAR OF EVENTS BOOKS

Alan met with Paul Swanson of Suburban Newspapers prior to the September meeting to confirm change book size and begin the process for setting up the 2014 Calendar of Events Book. Swanson is expecting that with the change in format size to 6" x10 1/2" and savings in printing costs that a total of 10,000 books will be printed for 2014. All pages will have the capability for color. It is anticipated that black-and-white ad rates may hold while color ad rates may increase.

On-Line Version: Secretary Tast reminded all that the entire 2014 book will be placed online, including advertising, as had been done for 2013. To access the Directory/Calendar, people will need to go the Council's website at www.enwicc.com and click on the photo of the cover page of the Directory.

Event Submittal Deadline January 14, 2014: Alan reminded all that event listings need to be submitted no later than January 14, 2014: a form will be included in the December newsletter (this can also be found in the front of the 2013 Calendar of Events book).

Club/Representative Updates for Calendar: All clubs need to provide Alan with updated listings for representatives and contact information at the December meeting, or contact Alan with this information prior to December 31st. The list will be available for last-minute corrections at the January meeting – it will be submitted to Suburban Newspapers for typesetting and printing immediately following.

Treasurer Boyd Reed reported that donations were made via distribution of checks from the Council to four previously-approved charities on behalf of the Council in the amount of \$250/each to the following:

2014 COUNCIL DUES NOW PAYABLE

VP Roy Murabito reminded all that 2014 Car Council dues have been payable as of October 1st and will be delinquent as of December 31st. Please remind your clubs that dues are 25 cents/member (minimum \$10/club) for the year. Checks may be made out to ENWICC-2014 Clubs delinquent after December 31st may pay their dues at the January meeting or mailed to the Treasurer (see inside of cover page for mailing address).

2014 PAUL HIGH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Roy Murabito announced that the Scholarship Committee has printed 120 application forms for mailings to high schools in the region with applications for the Paul High Memorial Scholarship program. Mailings will be made by the first weekend of January. It was noted that preference will be given to relatives of Council members should any apply for the scholarship.

BLUE-DOT TAILLIGHT FOLLOW-UP

Dave Vollmer and Roy Murabito provided some additional information related to people being fined for use of blue-dot taillights. While Roy noted that use of blue-dots was not directly covered by Nebraska law, Dave added that the law says that taillights are to be red, and that the shade of red is up to interpretation and within the realm of people charged with enforcement of the law. Dave will do more investigation into this.

NEW BUSINESS

JOSLYN CASTLE CAR SHOW NOT RETURNING FOR 2014

Jim Snyder informed everyone that after four good years of car shows at Joslyn Castle, management of the Castle and event organizers have parted ways and that the event has come to an end. Jim did mention that there are discussions ongoing between Jerry Vincentini Boys Town for a potential Concours on their campus in 2015. Jim also noted that a similar show at Salisbury House in Des Moines will be moving to downtown Des Moines in 2014.

COUNCIL OFFICER ELECTIONS IN MARCH

VP Murabito announced that elections for Council officers will take place at the March meeting in Lincoln, and made the first call for nominations. Nominations for the positions of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer will be accepted at the January, February and March meetings in Lincoln, with voting at the close of nominations and installation of new officers at the April meeting in Omaha.

BONDED AND ASSEMBLED TITLE DISCUSSION

Secretary Tast and Boyd Ready brought up discussion of bonded versus assembled titles in Nebraska in order to clarify requirements for a drive train to be present during inspection for a bonded title. For an assembled car title, the vehicle must be running. Vintage cars applying for a bonded title must have the correct drive train, but they do not have to run. Jim Snyder noted that Lancaster County has been particular about this for years: Alan noted that he first learned about the need for a drive train to be present when he visited with Sarpy County inspectors in November. Boyd also noted that receipts are needed for parts when applying for a bonded or assembled title.

PAST EVENTS

LATE FALL = LITTLE ACTIVITY

Among the events mentioned was the Mecum auction in Kansas City in early December. People noted that selling prices were low, with examples being a '67 Buick convertible going for \$4000 and a 1934 Ford Roadster crossing the block for \$28,000.
